TRIAL INFORMATION: Draw for run order will be after trial registration closes. Bitches in heat will run in order of draw, but must be crated and exercised away from the competition. Overflow judges may be hired and the limit of runs per day as well as judging assignments may change. All breeds recognized by ASCA as herding breeds are eligible to enter the trial. Owners of dogs will be responsible for all injuries to livestock; replacement cost will be determined at fair market value.

12 maximum cattle runs per trial - 13 minimum duck runs per trial - 25 minimum sheep runs per trial

Based on entries, the above listed limits may change and judging assignments may change. Any changes will be posted at the Trial Registration Desk in advance of the Trial starting.

FARM TRIAL (12 runs)

Open Level

1. Move 10 head from small round pen to large round pen (25 points)
2. Sort 5 unmarked head into take pen (25 points)
3. Take those 5 head to the trailer and load them on trailer (15 points)
4. Go back to round pen and take 5 marked head through take pen to feed pan at far end of arena and hold stock at pan. Gather will be 150 feet. (15 points)
5. You and dog go to the handler's post, leave dog at the post. Handler can go half way to stock, send dog to gather stock and take them to chute pen and put stock in pen (25 points)
6. Put stock in chute to vaccinate them, then remove them from chute and pen and put them back in take pen (25 points)

Advanced Level

Take stock out of barn and move to large round pen, then sort. Advanced dogs and handlers both stay at handler's post to gather stock to chute pen. 20 minutes per run.

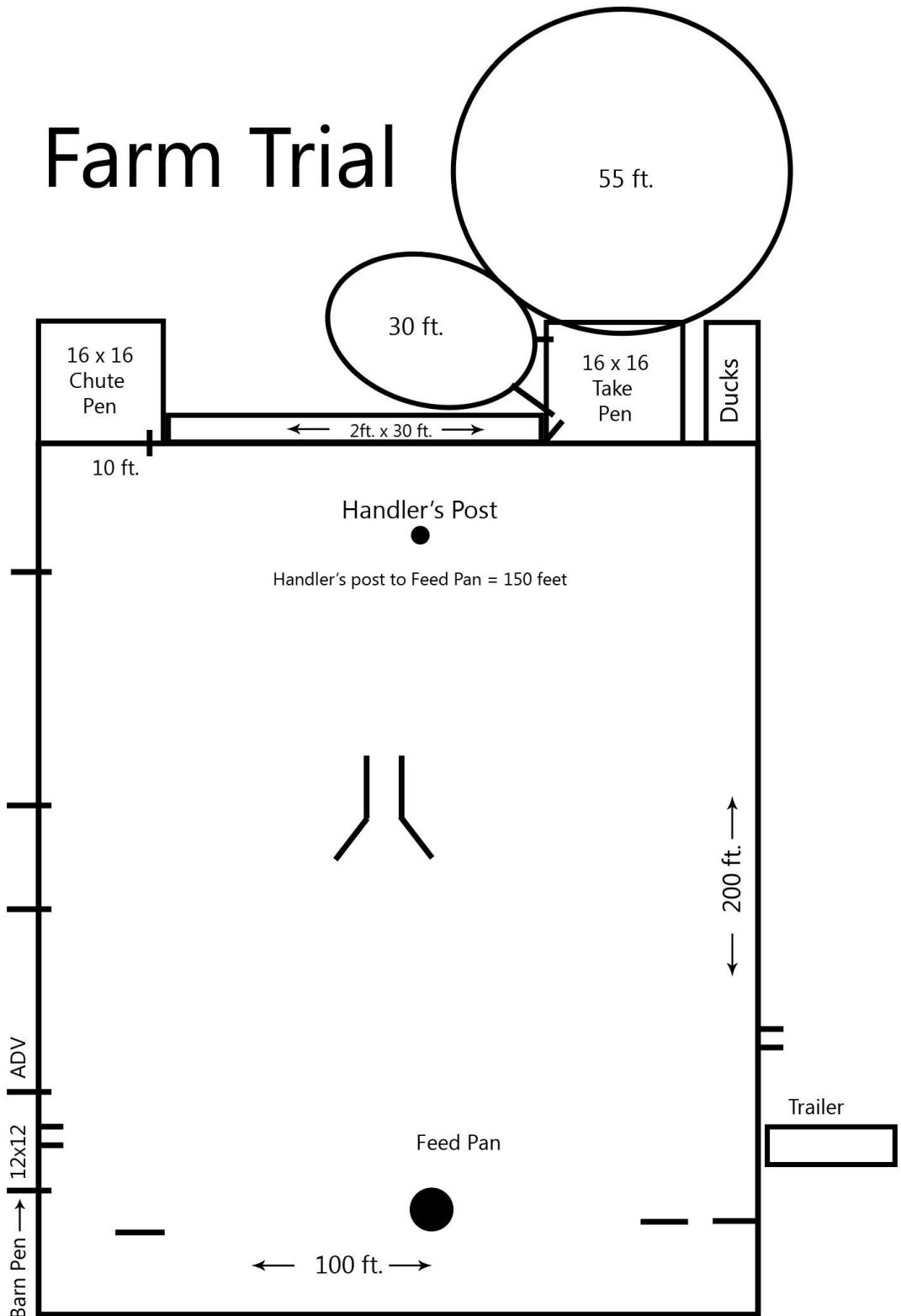
